Italian Growing Areas

Aglianico is a major pan-southern Italian red varietal grown in the region of Campania in the provinces of Benevento, Avellino, and Salerno, and in the region of Basilicata at Taurasi and on Monte Vulture on the slopes of an extinct volcano.

Aglianico, one of the oldest cultivated grapes, is often referred to as the “Nebbiolo of the South”.

Australian Vineyard Location

Central Victoria

The vineyard is located in foothills on the northern side of the Great Dividing Range, on Mt. Samaria, Central Victoria. The secluded vineyard is enclosed on three sides by state park and private forest.

Winemaking

The grapes received puncheon all natural vat fermentation and then transferred to old oak barriques for 18 months and in bottles for 18 months.
